Arts co-op hosts "Penny Dress"

The year 2013 will go down in history as the year of the demise of the penny.

In case you're already feeling nostalgic for the unappreciated cent, the Valley Artisans' Co-op invites you to stop by our location on the highway next to Harding's Pharmacy and have a look at the "Penny Dress."

Created by copper enamel artist Heidi den Hartog for Peterborough's annual Wearable Art Show, the dress is a stunning creation of copper pennies, black tulle and black fabric.

Den Hartog was inspired to use the humble penny for her piece when she heard that the currency would be withdrawn from circulation.

Featured on CTV, the Discovery Channel, Cross Country Check-Up and a string of newspaper outlets (including the NRT), the dress weighs around 5 kilos (12 pounds), and boasts nearly 2,000 pennies secured to the fabric with wire, thread and silicone.

It took den Hartog more than six weeks to create the piece for the Wearable Art Show, a fundraiser for Public Energy, a group that supports dance, art and artists in Peterborough.

To complement the Penny Dress, den Hartog has created enamelled penny earrings and pendants from vintage coins which are for sale at the co-op.

The Penny Dress is on loan to the Valley Artisans' Co-op for the summer months, so drop by to have a look at this unique piece of wearable art.
