



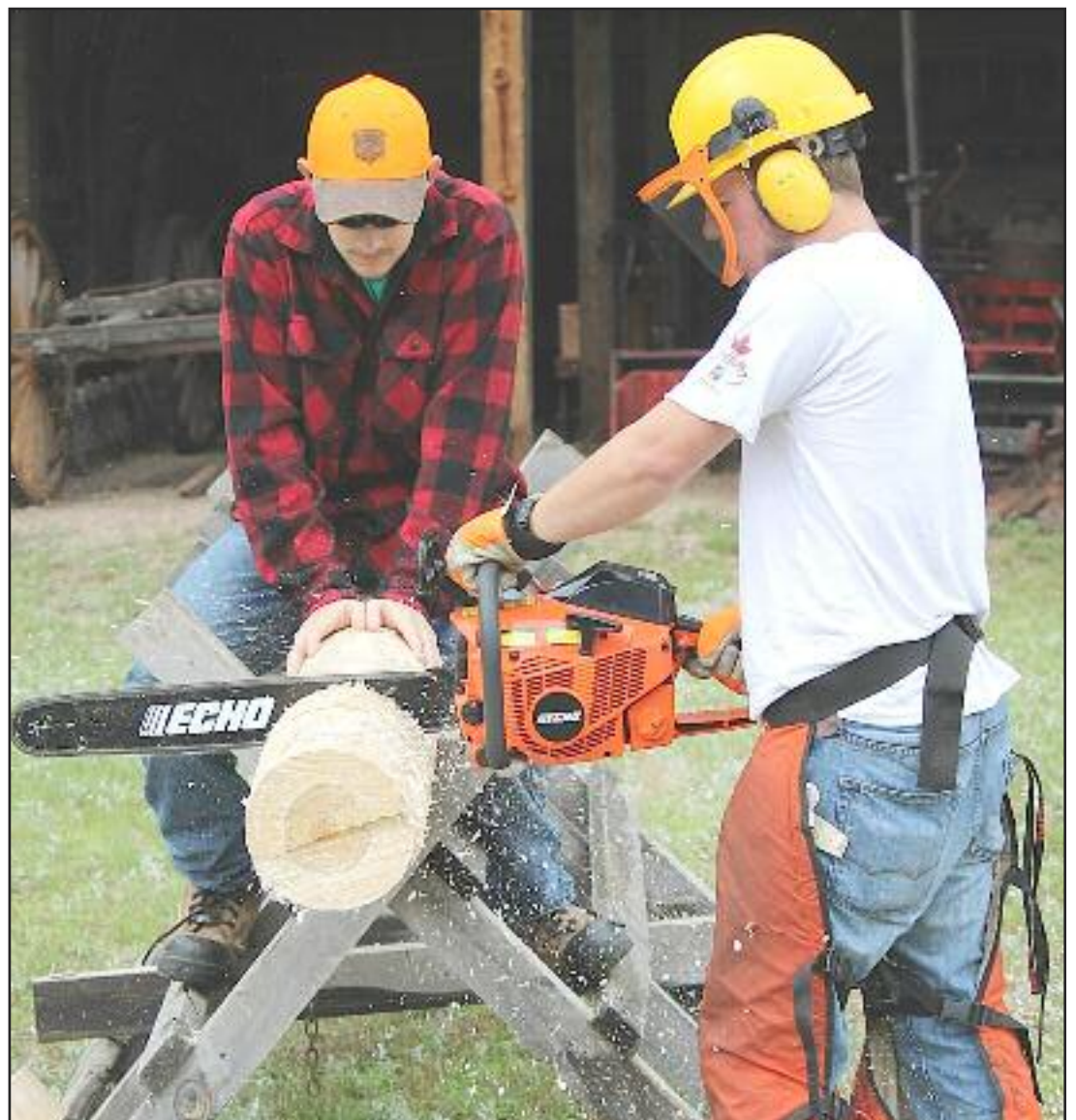


CAUSING A BUZZ AT THE RBWM HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S FUN DAY
