The campaign has raised \$2.45 million to date, with \$600,000 raised last year by animal lovers across Canada.

Guests donate to the participating animal welfare charity of the host's choice in exchange for a cupcake, raising critically needed funds for animals that are abused, abandoned, neglected or no longer wanted.
